Applicants will need to have the following information/documents on hand before beginning the online application. You will NOT be able to save your application and return to it at a later date:

1. The official online scholarship

- application form completed and signed.
- 2. Last official high school or college transcript.
- 3. Official SAT/ACT scores (high school students only).
- Two reference forms filled out and emailed before deadline.
- Answer to the Essay question: "Describe an event in which you took a leadership role and what you learned about yourself."
- 6. Current photograph

SkillsUSA Roofing Competition Pilot

The Georgia Roofing Contractors Association has been invited to pilot the first SkillsUSA state roofing competition in the country! The competition will be at the 2023 Career Expo/ SkillsUSA State Championships at the Georgia World Congress Center.

This all wouldn't be possible if it wasn't for the incredible support of the CEFGA team. CEFGA does an incredible job partnering with the Georgia Department of Education, employers, trade associations and philanthropic organizations to provide



support and services to construction programs in schools statewide. CEFGA has received national recognition for its annual CareerExpo and SkillsUSA State Championships, which draws more than 7,000 attendees annually; and its Construction Ready Program, which has trained and placed more than 500 residents in the construction industry since 2014.

We are looking for member companies to partner with local High Schools that are already teaching Construction and prepare the teachers/students for the 2023 competition using mockups and dedicated training time starting in the Fall 2023. CEFGA has put together a comprehensive list of Georgia schools that are offering construction classes that they have made available to us. The NRCA team is working with CEFGA to design the contest that will be TOP-focused including written questions, scoresheet, floor layout, materials needed, and tools needed.

There will be other opportunities to participate in this important event for this very important event, including determining prizes, run the competition and judge the students.

FINDING THE WORKERS OF TOMORROW TODAY: THE FUTURE

With the passage of the bipartisan infrastructure bill in early November 2021, the outlook for the roofing and construction industries could not be brighter. The country is poised to invest a whopping \$1 trillion (that's a one followed by **12 zeros**) in roads, bridges, rail, public transit, airports, ports, and community revitalization. Not since the original legislation signed by President Dwight D. Eisenhower on June 29, 1956, funding the U.S. Interstate Highway System, have the needs of the construction industry been so front and center. Business will be plentiful but finding the labor to take on the contracts is the real challenge. Now is the time to think strategically about your process for finding and retaining skilled talent.

UTILIZE INDUSTRY SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS

The Georgia Roofing Contractors Association of Georgia (GARCA) and The Construction Education Foundation of Georgia (CEFGA) are just two of the state organizations that have programs and resources devoted to helping state roofing businesses find and train the next generation of construction workers. These organizations are working in tandem with each other and business owners to develop sustainable programs and promote the benefits of a career in the skilled trades.

DEVELOP RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE LOCAL HIGH SCHOOLS

Whether working through CEFGA, or contacting the schools personally, the local high school has a ready pool of students who want options beside attending college following graduation. Take the time to meet with local Principals, FBLA-PBL Sponsors, and PTSA Executive Board members. These adults have a vested interest in creating opportunities for the students they supervise. Offering structured internships, part-time and summer employment is a great way to fill your labor needs and introduce students to the opportunities available in the construction trades.

NOTE: In preparation for the 2023 SkillsUSA Roofing Competition, we encourage everyone to partner with their local High Schools and prepare teachers/students for the competition using mockups and dedicated training time. The goal would be to conduct (4) 45-80 minute training sessions, depending on the length of the class period, in 2022. If you would be interested in obtaining contact information for those teachers and counselors at the high schools in your community that are currently offering construction courses, you can contact Betsy Rahm at info@qarca.org. CONTACT THE CAREER CENTER OF YOUR LOCAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR FOUR-YEAR UNIVERSITY

Not every community has a two- or four-year institution of higher education; however, if a higher education school exists in your community, this is again a good place to look for labor. College students need part-time and summer jobs, but in addition, students studying business or engineering will appreciate




